

HILO HARBOR



Hilo Harbor's basin measures 1,400-feet wide by 2,300-feet long and is protected by a 10,000-foot breakwater. The depth in the entrance channel is 35 feet. Berth space at Pier 1 is 1,265 feet with an additional 703 feet at Pier 2 and 637 feet at Pier 3. Along side depth at each pier is between 33 and 35 feet. The combined cargo handling and storage area totals over 595,000 square feet.
