**SUBCHAPTER 3  
WATERWAYS**

**§19-42-85** Maximum speed of vessels. All vessels over sixty-five feet shall proceed at a rate of speed (except in case of emergency) commensurate with safe navigation and slow enough so as not to cause damage to other vessels and property.

Vessels under sixty-five feet may proceed at a rate of speed not to exceed ten nautical miles per hour.

Nothing in this section shall preclude harbor masters from setting a different rate of speed to meet special conditions. [Eff 5/20/82; comp 2/26/96] (Auth: HRS §§266-2, 266-3) (Imp: HRS §§266-2, 266-3)
