

§19-43-25 Authority to remove illegally parked cars. The department may remove or cause to be removed:

- (1) Any vehicle which is left unattended upon a street and is so parked illegally as to constitute a definite hazard or obstruction to the normal movement of traffic.
- (2) Any vehicle which is left unattended upon a street, or area within the state commercial harbor facility, which interferes with or impedes construction or repairs made thereon, provided adequate signs giving notice of construction and prohibiting such parking and designating the time of prohibition are properly posted by the division.
- (3) Any vehicle which is left unattended upon any portion or area within the commercial harbor facility within ten feet of a fire hydrant.
