It is my pleasure to express support for the State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation, Harbors Division's application for the *Pier 4 Wharf Improvement Project*, Hilo Harbor, Hawaii Island, to receive TIGER funding. This action will result in the construction of a new 602-foot long wharf that will be an invaluable asset to supporting interisland shipments of goods.
