

IDENTIFICATION AND LEGAL PRESENCE

To apply for a new or renewed driver's license, you must show:

- Proof of Identity. Documents must show your full legal name and date of birth. Nicknames and abbreviations will not be accepted.
- Proof of Legal Presence in the United States. A U.S. birth certificate or unexpired U.S. passport will serve as both proof of identity and proof of legal presence.
- Social Security Number. Your number will be verified with the Social Security Administration. If your social security number does not match the SSN on file at the Social Security Administration, you will not be issued a driver's license or permit.

All documents must be originals or certified copies. Photocopies will not be accepted. For a list of acceptable documents, refer to "Acceptable Documents for Obtaining a Driver's License" at <http://hawaii.gov/dot/hawaiiis-legal-presence-law>.
