Hawaii Foodservice Alliance, L.L.C. (HFA), whose mailing address is 2720 Waiwai Loop, Honolulu, Hawaii 96819.

CURRENT USE STATUS:

Land presently encumbered by Governors Executive Order No. 3074, dated August 20, 1981, setting aside 4,204.10 acres designated as KOA under the control and management of the State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation (HDOT) for Airport Purposes.

CHARACTER OF USE:

HFA will use the cargo building spaces to store perishable and dry goods, and office space, and the ramp space for a storage container to support its freight handling operation at KOA.

COMMENCEMENT DATE:

To be determined by the Director of Transportation at a later date.

MONTHLY RENTAL:

\$3,833.08 (\$3,386.83 based on a rate of \$13.20 per square foot per annum for cargo space and \$3.43 per square foot per annum for improved, paved land as determined from the HDOT schedule of rates and charges established by appraisal of Airports property statewide, plus \$446.25 for maintenance).

CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The HDOT has determined the subject land area pertaining to this action was evaluated for environmental impact by the Keahole Airport Master Plan Final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), published in The Environmental Notice on November 8, 1988,

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and accepted by the Governor on December 19, 1988. This action is consistent with the 1988 EIS and the same mitigation conditions apply.

REMARKS:

The HDOT proposes to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to HFA for cargo building spaces to store perishable and dry goods, and office space, and ramp space for a storage container to support its freight handling operation at KOA.

RECOMMENDATION:

Based on this submittal, and testimony and facts presented, the HDOT recommends the Director of Transportation finds that approving the issuance of a month-to-month Revocable Permit to HFA including its conditions and rent, will serve the best interests of the State.
