American will use the space to install passenger check-in kiosks to support its signatory air carrier operation.

CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The HDOT has determined that the subject area and use is covered by the Kahului Airport Terminal Complex Expansion Negative Declaration, published by the Environmental Quality Commission in the September 8, 1981, issue of the EQC Bulletin. Accordingly, all relevant mitigation from the Negative Declaration and best management practices will be implemented to address the minimum impacts of this action.

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REMARKS:

The HDOT proposes to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to American for terminal space to install passenger check-in kiosks to support its signatory air carrier operation.

RECOMMENDATION:

Based on this submittal, and testimony and facts presented, the HDOT recommends the Director of Transportation finds that approving the issuance of a month-to-month Revocable Permit to American, including its conditions and rent, will serve the best interests of the State.
