REQUEST:

Issuance of a Revocable Permit for a construction field office to Oceanit Laboratories, Inc., situated at Daniel K. Inouye International Airport.

CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The environmental impacts of the proposed action to the subject land area are covered by the Honolulu International Airport, Airport Modernization Program Environmental Assessment (EA), State Project No. AO1030-13. The EA is a joint State and Federal document dated January 2013, and published in the February 8, 2013 issue of the OEQC Bulletin. Accordingly, the actions have been determined to have little or no impact upon the environment.

REMARKS:

In accordance with Section 171-55, HRS, relating to Permits, HDOT proposes to issue a revocable permit to Oceanit for the use of the space as a construction field office, as specifically stated in Contract No. 71601, State Project No. CS1338-18, General Engineering Services for the Oahu District Airports, Daniel K. Inouye International Airport, "Pending the availability of space on airport property, the State will issue a Revocable Permit (s) to the Contractor for the use of the space, assessed at a monthly fee of \$25.00 for each Revocable Permit issued." The space (s) may be used as a field office, staging of materials and equipment, and or other uses subject to the approval of the State..."

RECOMMENDATION:

Based on this submittal, and testimony and facts presented, the HDOT recommends the Director of Transportation finds that approving the issuance of a month-to-month revocable permit to Oceanit, including its conditions and rent, will serve the best interests of the State.
