# Sources of Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Funds Managed by HDOT

- State SRTS program special fund
  - Previously discussed and more details to follow
- Federal funds obtained under SAFETEA-LU
  - \$8 million received from 2005 to 2012
  - HDOT awarded funds to eligible recipients for various infrastructure and non-infrastructure projects through seven rounds of Call for Applications under 3-122-16.31, HAR
  - Partnered with counties to conduct informational workshops before most Call for Applications
  - Current available balance= approximately \$1 million, which HDOT plans to use towards Farrington Highway sidewalk improvements, Hakimo Road to Nanakuli Avenue

# State SRTS Program Special Fund

- Act 317 (2012)
- Established a state SRTS program special fund consisting of SRTS program surcharges
  - o \$25 for speeding in a school zone
  - o \$10 for speeding violations under HRS Chapter 291C, Part X
  - o \$10 for various other violations under HRS Chapter 291, Part I
- Required that HDOT distribute funds from the SRTS special fund to counties
- HDOT adopted Chapter 19-109, HAR
- HDOT distributed \$4.5 million from the SRTS program special fund to counties from FY 2014 to FY 2020
- Act 9 (Special Session 2021)
  - Required that the legislature appropriate funds from the SRTS special fund to counties

# State SRTS Program Special Fund (continued)

- Act 244 (2023)
- Committee chair previously discussed
- Current balance = \$12.2 million
- Anticipate additional \$10 million transferred from the state highway fund in FY 25
- Continuing to accumulate surcharges on violations, average annual amount= approximately \$410,000 based on FY 23.
- Budget authority for FY 25= \$10 million
- Coordinated with counties to compile list of possible SRTS projects, total = \$6 million
