LOCATION AND TAX MAP KEY:

Portion of Kahului Airport, Kahului, Island of Maui, identified by Tax Map Key: 2nd Division, 3-8-001: Portion of 019.

Building/Room No. 311-102, containing an area of approximately 50 square feet, as shown and delineated on the attached Exhibit A.

LAND TITLE STATUS:

CURRENT USE STATUS:

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 2427, dated February 12, 1969, setting aside 1,268.938 acres designated as Kahului Airport to be under the control and management of the State of Hawaii Department of Transportation (HDOT) for Airport purposes.

CHARACTER OF USE:

AAI will use the space to install passenger check-in kiosks for its signatory airline carrier operation.

COMMENCEMENT DATE:

To be determined by the Director of Transportation at a later date.

MONTHLY RENTAL:

\$448.33 (\$107.60 per square foot, per annum, as determined from the Airports Signatory Carriers Rates and Charges, Hawaii Airports System, effective July 1, 2024).

SECURITY DEPOSIT:

\$1,344.99, or three times the monthly rental in effect.

CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The HDOT has determined that the subject land area and use is covered by the Kahului Airport Terminal Complex Expansion Negative Declaration, published by the Environmental Quality Commission (EQC) in the September 8, 1981, issue of the EQC

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Bulletin. Accordingly, all relevant mitigation from the Negative Declaration and best management practices will be implemented to address the minimum impacts of this action.

REMARKS:

The HDOT proposes to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to AAI for terminal floor space to install passenger check-in kiosks for its signatory airline carrier operation.

RECOMMENDATION:

Based on this submittal, and testimony and facts presented, the HDOT recommends the Director of Transportation finds that approving the issuance of a month-to-month revocable permit to AAI including its conditions and rent, will serve the best interests of the State.
