## **CURRENT USE STATUS:**

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 2653, dated March 5, 1973, setting aside 284.466 acres designated as General Lyman Field under the control and management of the State of Hawaii Department of Transportation (HDOT) for public purposes.

## **CHARACTER OF USE:**

Oshkosh will use the space for terminal office and parts and equipment ramp storage for the maintenance of the jet bridges and baggage handling system at ITO.

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#### CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The HDOT has determined that the subject areas are covered by the Hilo International Airport Final Environmental Assessment (FEA), dated April 15, 2003, and published by the Office of Environmental Quality Control in the May 8, 2003 issue of The Environmental Notice. Accordingly, all relevant mitigation from the FEA and best management practices will be implemented to address the minimum impacts of this action.

## **REMARKS:**

The HDOT proposes to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to Oshkosh for terminal office and parts and equipment ramp storage for the maintenance of the jet bridges and baggage handling system at ITO.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Based on this submittal, and testimony and facts presented, the HDOT recommends the Director of Transportation finds that approving the issuance of a month-to-month revocable permit to Oshkosh including its conditions and rent, will serve the best interests of the State.
