LOCATION AND TAX MAP KEY:

Portion of Kahului Airport, Kahului, Island of Maui, identified by Tax Map Key: 2nd Division, 3-8-001: Portion of 142 and Portion of 246.

AREA:

Building/Room No. 117-101, containing an area of approximately 757 square feet, Building/Room No. 117-118, containing an area of approximately 546 square feet, and Building/Room No. 103-103, containing an area of approximately 2,094 square feet, as shown and delineated on the attached maps labeled Exhibit A and Exhibit B.

ZONING:

State Land Use District: Urban County of Maui: Airport

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LAND TITLE STATUS:

Section 5(a) lands of the Hawaii Admission Act: Non-Ceded

DHHL 30% entitlement lands pursuant to Hawaii Admission Act YES____NO_X_

CURRENT USE STATUS:

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 2427, dated February 12, 1969, setting aside 1,268.938 acres designated as Kahului Airport to be under the control and management of the State of Hawaii Department of Transportation (HDOT) for public purposes.

CHARACTER OF USE:

Daifuku will use the spaces for offices and storage for jet bridge and baggage system maintenance operations.

COMMENCEMENT DATE:

Upon execution of the revocable permit.

MONTHLY RENTAL:

\$6,882.23 (\$5,047.85 as determined from the HDOT Schedule of Rates and Charges established by appraisal of Airports property statewide, plus \$1,324.83 for utilities and \$509.55 for maintenance).

SECURITY DEPOSIT:

\$20,646.69, or three times the monthly rental in effect.

CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The HDOT has determined that the subject land area and use is covered by the Kahului Airport Terminal Complex Expansion Negative Declaration, published by the Environmental Quality Commission (EQC) in the September 8, 1981, issue of the EQC

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Bulletin. Accordingly, all relevant mitigation from the Negative Declaration and best management practices will be implemented to address the minimum impacts of this action.

REMARKS:

HDOT proposes to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to Daifuku for storage and office spaces for jet bridge and baggage system maintenance operations.

RECOMMENDATION:

Based on this submittal, and testimony and facts presented, the HDOT recommends the Director of Transportation finds that approving the issuance of a month-to-month revocable permit to Daifuku, including its conditions and rent, will serve the best interests of the State.
