## **CURRENT USE STATUS:**

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 2427, dated February 12, 1969, setting aside 1,268.938 acres designated as Kahului Airport to be under the control and management of the State of Hawaii Department of Transportation (HDOT) for Airport purposes.

## **CHARACTER OF USE:**

United will use the main terminal space for employee training to support its signatory air carrier operation.

### **COMMENCEMENT DATE:**

To be determined by the Director of Transportation at a later date.

### MONTHLY RENTAL:

\$3,891.96 (\$120.37 per square foot, per annum, as determined from the Airports Signatory Carriers Rates and Charges, Hawaii Airports System, effective July 1, 2025).

# CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The HDOT has determined that the subject area and use is covered by the Kahului Airport Terminal Complex Expansion Negative Declaration, published by the Environmental Quality Commission in the September 8, 1981, issue of the EQC Bulletin. Accordingly, all relevant mitigation from the Negative Declaration and best management practices will be implemented to address the minimum impacts of this action.
