Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 2653, dated March 5, 1973, setting aside 284.466 acres designated as General Lyman Field under the control and management of the State of Hawaii Department of Transportation (HDOT) for public purposes.

CHARACTER OF USE:

WRSA will use the spaces as a field office and vehicle parking for State Project No. AH1021-19, Taxiway and Runway Lighting Replacement.

COMMENCEMENT DATE:

Upon execution of the revocable permit.

MONTHLY RENTAL:

\$25.00 per month as specifically stated in Contract No. 70898, State Project No. AH1021-19, Taxiway and Runway Lighting Replacement, Attachment S1, Section 1.4 Field Office, which states in part, "Pending the availability of space on airport property, the State may issue a Revocable Permit (RP) to the Contractor for the use of the space, assessed at a nominal monthly fee specified for the respective airport for each Revocable Permit issued. The space(s) shall be used only for a field office, and subject to the approval of the State, vehicle parking may be allowed."

\$75.00, or three times the monthly rental in effect.

CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The HDOT has determined that the subject areas are covered by the Hilo International Airport Final Environmental Assessment (FEA), dated April 15, 2003, and published by the Office of Environmental Quality Control in the May 8, 2003 issue of The Environmental Notice. Accordingly, all relevant mitigation from the FEA and best management practices will be implemented to address the minimum impacts of this action.

REMARKS:

The HDOT proposes to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to WRSA for office space and vehicle parking for Contract No. 70898, State Project No. AH1021-19, Taxiway and Runway Lighting Replacement.

RECOMMENDATION:

Based on this submittal, and testimony and facts presented, the HDOT recommends the Director of Transportation finds that approving the issuance of a month-to-month revocable permit to WRSA, including its conditions and rent, will serve the best interests of the State.
