AMENDMENT TO CONCESSION AGREEMENT NO. DOT-A-11-0006 FOR ADDITIONAL SEATING AREA AND A PROPANE TANK SPACE HOST INTERNATIONAL, INC. LIHUE AIRPORT

PURPOSE:

To amend the existing Restaurant and Lounge Concession Agreement No. DOT-A-11-0006 to allow for an expanded seating area and a propane tank space at Lihue Airport.

CONCESSIONAIRE:

Host International, Inc., whose business address is 6905 Rockledge Drive, Bethesda, Maryland 20817.

LEGAL REFERENCE:

CONCESSION TERM:

To run for the balance of the term of the existing concession agreement that ends on September 30, 2031.

ADDITIONAL PREMISES:

Building/Room No. 306-279, containing an area of approximately 348 square feet, as shown and delineated on the attached Exhibit J.

Area/Space No. 514-101L, containing an area of approximately 207 square feet, as shown and delineated on the attached Exhibit K.

IMPROVEMENTS:

The Concessionaire will be solely responsible for any renovations, upgrades, remodeling, and improvements to the additional spaces, at their own expense.

CONCESSION FEE:

No additional rent will be charged for the seating area; however, all revenue generated by the entire restaurant establishment shall be reported as gross receipts in accordance with the Concession Agreement.

The annual rent for the propane tank space is \$815.58, calculated based on the minimum rental rate of \$3.94 per square foot per annum, as set forth in the Schedule of Rates and Charges established through the appraisal of Airports' property statewide.

CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The State of Hawaii Department of Transportation (HDOT) has determined that the environment impacts of the proposed subject land use is covered by the Lihue Airport Improvements Final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), published by the Office of Environmental Quality Control in the November 23, 2007, issue of the Environmental Notice. Accordingly, all relevant mitigation from the EIS and best management practices will be implemented to address the minimum impacts of this action.

REMARKS:

The HDOT and Host International, Inc. entered into Concession Agreement No. DOT-A-11-0006, dated September 8, 2011, for the Restaurant and Lounge Concession at Lihue Airport. The additional seating will improve the experience and comfort of travelers as they enjoy their food and drinks, while the designated space for a propane tank will support business operations.

RECOMMENDATION:


