

Landscaping Materials Guide

FERTILIZER AND PESTICIDES STORAGE AND APPLICATION BMPS

- Store fertilizers and pesticides in accordance with the Container and Material Storage BMPs to minimize contact with stormwater runoff.
- Periodically check the condition of containers. Look for leaking or corroded containers, crystallization on covers or bases of containers, or discolored labels. Dispose unnecessary containers properly in accordance with the Solid Waste Storage and Disposal BMP.
- Do not apply when heavy rain or wind is expected.
- Do not spray within six-feet of a water body.
- Do not over apply and ensure that all application is away from the DOTA MS4, drainage system, or State waters.
- Use natural or organic alternatives, if possible.
- Follow all rules and laws, refer to the Hawaii Department of Agriculture, Plant Industry Division, Pesticides Branch for more information on the following: Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR), Chapter 66 Pesticides; and Hawaii Revised Statues (HRS), Hawaii Pesticide Law, Chapter 149A.

RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDES (RUPs)

- Do not use chemicals listed as RUPs in HAR AR-66 Section 4-66-32 on DOTA property.
- Review RUP list before purchasing products and refrain from using these products if they are currently in your possession.
- It is a violation of state and federal law to use RUP's unless the person is a certified pesticide applicator or under the direct supervision of a certified pesticide applicator.
- RUPs are pesticides that require a specific license to use or purchase.
 All pesticides available at general home improvement store are not RUPs and acceptable to use.
