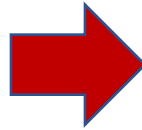




## HAWAII DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, AIRPORTS DIVISION 2020 LOGO UPDATE



*The Dept. of Transportation (DOT) Airports Division has adopted Mālama I Ka Wai water drop fish logo to further unify itself with DOT Harbors and DOT Highways. The old COP logo has been retired and the new logo was officially debuted November 1, 2019. With the other two divisions' logos already having a strong presence in the public, the Airports Division's adoption of the logo will help to emphasize the DOT's message to protect our waters.*



- **THE AIRPORTS VERSION OF THE WATER DROP LOGO WAS DESIGNED TO INCLUDE THE AIRPORTS DIVISION NAME TO DISTINGUISH IT FROM THE OTHER DIVISIONS. NOW, EACH DOT DIVISION POSSESSES ITS OWN SPIN ON THE LOGO, WHILE CONTINUING TO UPHOLD THE MESSAGE TO PROTECT OUR OCEANS AND PREVENT STORMWATER POLLUTION.**
