1. General liability insurance for limit of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate. The STATE shall be named as additional insured.

- 2. Automobile liability insurance for limit of not less than \$1,000,000 per accident. The STATE shall be named as additional insured.
- 3. Professional liability insurance for limit of not less than \$1,000,000 per claim and \$2,000,000 annual aggregate.

If your firm is not able to provide the above insurance certificate at this time, a letter from an insurance company stating, if the firm is selected, that they will insure the firm for the insurance policies and the amount of minimum coverage required above, will be accepted as proof of insurance.

Further, the following verbiage related to this insurance requirement shall be incorporated into any executed contract with the STATE:

- The CONTRACTOR will immediately provide written notice to the contracting department or agency should any of the insurance policies evidenced on its Certificate of Insurance form be canceled, limited in scope, or not renewed upon expiration.
- 2. The STATE is added as an additional insured as respects to operations performed for the STATE; and,
- 3. It is agreed that any insurance maintained by the STATE will apply in excess of, and not contribute with, insurance provided by this policy.
