HARBOR MASTER NOTICE
HMN-M-02.24

DISCHARGE AND RECEPTION OF REGULATED WASTES AT HAWAII DEPARTMENT
OF TRANSPORTATION PORTS AT HAWAII DISTRICT, MAUI DISTRICT, AND KAUAI
DISTRICT PROHIBITED

HDOT determines that the commercial ports in its Hawaii District, Maui District, and Kauai District are inadequate reception facilities for regulated wastes including oil, Noxious Liquid Substances (NLS), garbage, Ozone Depleting Substances (ODS), and Exhaust Gas Cleaning System (EGCS) residue wastes. Discharge of these wastes by vessels at ports in these districts are prohibited. To comply with the requirements set forth in 33 CFR part 158, these wastes shall only be discharged at either Honolulu Harbor or Kalaeloa Barbers Point Harbor in Oahu District as these facilities have the requisite U.S. Coast Guard Certificate of Adequacy (COA).

Effective July 1, 2024, regulated wastes will not be accepted at Hilo Harbor, Kawaihae Harbor, Kahului Harbor, Kaunakakai Harbor, Kaunapau Harbor and Nawiliwili Harbor.

Vessel owners, masters, crew, and agents are hereby provided notice that the discharge, reception, and disposal of oil, Noxious Liquid Substances (NLS), garbage, Ozone Depleting Substances (ODS), and Exhaust Gas Cleaning System (EGCS) residue wastes shall only be performed by a properly certified vendor at Honolulu Harbor or Kalaeloa Barbers Point Harbor.
