§19-141-1 Purpose. The purpose of this chapter is to ensure that the State complies with the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations. §19-141-2 Definitions. Unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, as used in this chapter: "Director" means the director of the state department of transportation.



"Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations" means Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Parts 383, 385, 386, 390-399.




