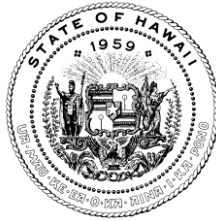

**SUBJECT: DRAFT Burial Treatment Plan Addendum for SIHP #50-10-27-22415, Honokōhau 1st, North Kona District, Hawai'i Island, TMK: (3) 7-4-008:999 (State Right-of-Way) and 010 (Kaloko-Honokōhau National Historical Park).**

On October 12, 2018, the Department of Transportation (HDOT) and Cultural Surveys Hawai'i (CSH) received correspondence from our office (LOG NO. 2015.03584, DOC NO. 1810RKH07) regarding "acceptance" of the above DRAFT Burial Treatment Plan (BTP) Addendum. It came to our attention, shortly after this letter had been distributed, that CSH required additional time to amend the BTP Addendum to include further consultation with descendants.

Therefore, SHPD rescinds the decision within our former letter, dated October 12, 2018, to accept the previous (September 2015) BTP Addendum to instead, accept the revised (December 2018) BTP Addendum that was submitted to our office via email on December 12, 2018.

**Again, the revised BTP Addendum is accepted.**

Please change the wording of the title from "Draft" to "Final" and submit hard copies of the final version with a text-searchable PDF CD to both, our Kapolei and Hilo Offices.
