PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The project will build a new, elevated pedestrian walkway over Ala Moana Boulevard to remove pedestrian traffic out of the existing at-grade intersection.

The project will provide a safe and efficient way for pedestrians to cross over the busy highway and reduce vehicle-pedestrian accidents at this intersection, where there is currently no elevated walkway over the existing state highway.
