PLEASE HELP SAVE LIVES & PROPERTY

As the operator of a motor vehicle, we know you appreciate the true life and death realities associated with following the rules of the road. Since so many crashes occur as a result of running red lights, the Hawaii Department of Transportation hosts cameras at signalized intersections around our community to help ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians, and cyclists. This program is known as the Hawaii Red-Light Safety Program.

The Hawaii Red-Light Safety Program uses automated camera systems and sensors to detect red light infractions pursuant to HRS chapter 291J. A red-light infraction consists of vehicles illegally entering the intersection during the red-light phase. Once citations start getting issued as part of the Program, the Notice of Traffic Infraction will include information relevant to the incident, as well as still images of the incident with date, time, and location where the infraction occurred.

The following vehicle registered in your name failed to come to a complete stop at the location indicated, which constitutes an infraction of HRS §291C-32(c):
