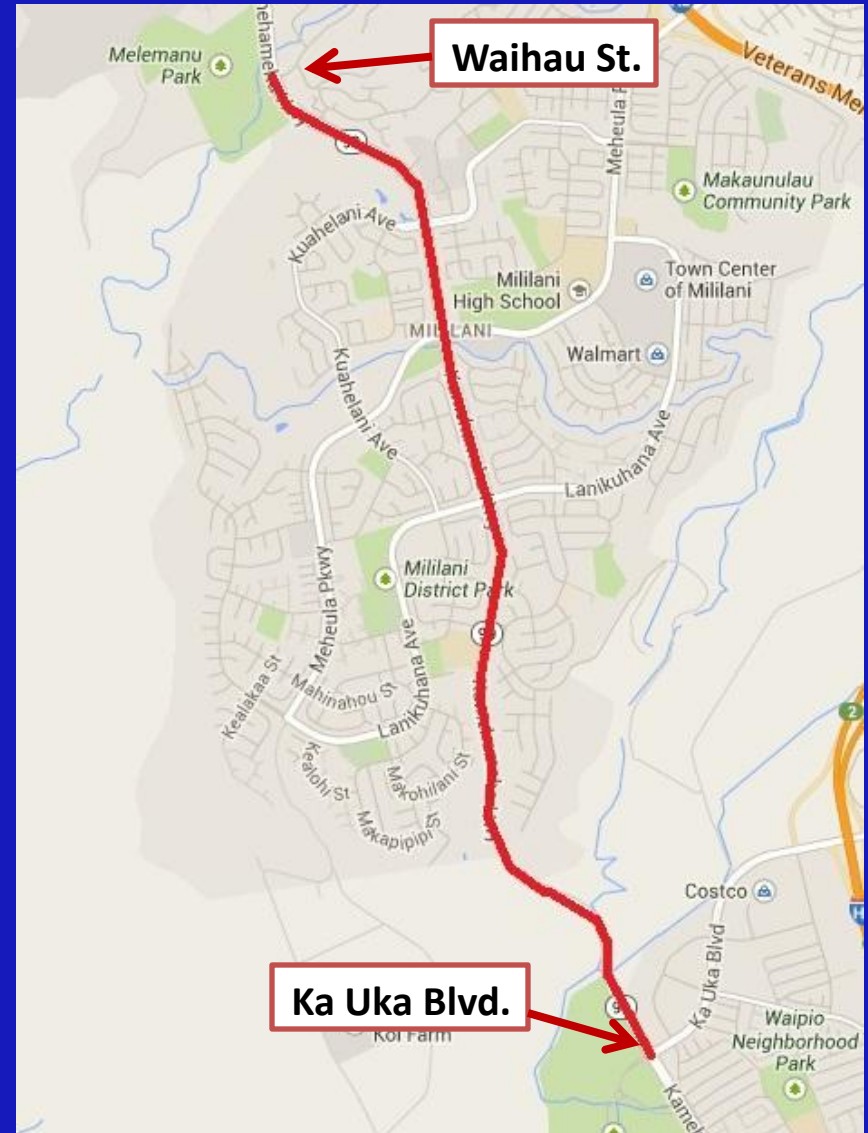




Kamehameha Highway Resurfacing Project

Project Scope

- Project limits: Ka Uka Boulevard to the vicinity of Waihau Street
- 13.72 lane miles of roadway reconstructed
- \$13.3 million
- 80% federal, 20% state funds

Project Information

- Last resurfaced in 1991
- Roadway resurfacing and reconstruction, guardrail improvements and traffic signal replacements.

Project Schedule

- Monday – Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. excluding holidays
- First Phase: Northbound single lane closures from Ka Uka Blvd. to Kipapa Bridge
- Full nighttime closures of the Kipapa Bridge toward the end of the project
