

NOTICE AND INFORMATION REGARDING UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION WORK (NIMITZ VIADUCT BIKE PATH)

The Department of Transportation, Highways Division (HDOT), will be conducting necessary construction work along the Nimitz Viaduct Bike Path <u>beginning on November 4, 2016 and ending on November 19, 2016.</u> During this time period, the area on the perimeter of the path will be closed to the general public for health and safety reasons. Additionally, if you have personal property in this state highway right-of-way area, please see the attached Notice to Remove Objects requiring removal of unauthorized objects from this area. Please note that State of Hawaii law prohibits the placement or storage of structures, vehicles, equipment, or other objects within the state highway right-of-way without permission of the HDOT.
