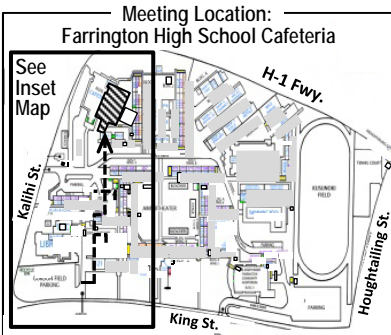

The Hawaii Department of Transportation, Harbors Division (DOT-H) invites the community to a public informational meeting regarding the relocation of the iHeart Radio Broadcast Tower, currently situated near the corner of Dillingham Blvd. and Kokea St. The purpose of the meeting is to apprise the public about the project and to solicit input on the site selection process. Relocation of the tower is proposed to improve local operational efficiencies of the maritime and aviation industries. Five radio stations currently transmit from the tower, including KSSK 590 AM, which is designated as one of the State's civil defense emergency alert system (EAS) broadcasters. Therefore, the identification of a suitable relocation site is vital to ensure continued, uninterrupted EAS service as a matter of public safety.
