



KALAELOA BARBERS POINT HARBOR FUEL PIER HARBOR IMPROVEMENTS DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT PUBLIC MEETING

WEDNESDAY | MARCH 1, 2017

The Hawai'i Department of Transportation, Harbors Division (DOT-H) invites the community to learn more about the improvements proposed in the Kalaeloa Barbers Point Harbor Fuel Pier and Harbor Improvements Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS). DOT-H is proposing to build a new, dedicated Fuel Pier to accommodate the various types of fuel that currently serve and could potentially serve the state's fuel and energy markets. In addition, a number of other improvements are being proposed to improve berthing and operational efficiencies at the harbor.

DOT-H has prepared a Draft EIS to analyze potential environmental impacts on resources and propose mitigation. DOT-H will hold a public meeting to present details about the proposed improvements and findings of the Draft EIS. Public input is welcome.
