### COMMUNITY NOISE CONTROL, VARIANCE APPLICATION

The State of Hawaii Department of Transportation, Highways Division (HDOT) encourages all interested individuals and organizations to comment on the Community Noise Variance Application informing the public of construction work and the proposed night and weekend work on the Installation of Enhanced Pavement Marking and New Milled Rumble Strip at Various Locations around Oahu.

The scope of the project involves the installation of pavement markings and milled rumble strips at various locations on the Island of Oahu. Pavement marking installation involves removing the existing pavement marking, laying out and installing new pavement striping, crosswalk markings, pavement arrows, pavement words, delineators, and pavement markers. The addition of milled rumble strips involves the installation of a milled rumble strip along the centerline and / or along the outside travel lane of the road.

This three (3) year project is estimated to begin as early as October 2019, with major construction activities expected to be completed by approximately October 2022.

Pursuant to the Hawaii Revised Statutes, Chapter 342F-5, Subsection (h), HDOT seeks written comments from interested persons regarding the Community Noise Variance Application for this project.
