

DISTRICT 44 UPDATE – JULY 2024

### SPEED MITIGATION

- Installed three raised crosswalks in Mā'ili November 2023
- Installed four on DHHL Pohakunui Avenue July 2024
- Data shows decrease in drivers going over the speed limit (e.g., from 53% of drivers going over 35 mph to 28% at Farrington Highway and Piliokahi)

## MA'IPALAOA BRIDGE

Awarded in 2016 for \$14.4M - defaulted

CONSTRUCTION BEGAN AUGUST 2019 initial EST completion date 1/2022

NEW EST COMPLETION – end of October 2024 (note, this has been shifted since the July town hall due to contractor rework)

- -BWS had planned water system improvements, so bridge project was redesigned to increase the watermain on the side of the bridge to a 12-inch diameter
- -During construction found an underground fiberoptic cable (not able to tone due to water/coral) that conflicts with drilled shafts



## MĀKAHA BRIDGES NO. 3 & 3A

- Bridges were Numbers 1 & 3 on the bridge priority list for replacement/repair
- HDOT repaired decks biennially at cost of \$500,000
- Construction began March 2021
- Completion of striping, construction of an access road, chain link fence installation, and landscaping anticipated
  September 30, 2024 (note, this has been shifted since the July town hall)



# VEGETATION MANAGEMENT



- HDOT is coordinating with HFD to prioritize areas for fuel reduction
- Areas identified for Leeward O'ahu included 16 acres at:
  - H-1 eastbound Kapolei Knolls
  - Ka Makana Alii
  - Kili Drive
  - Farrington Highway at Honokai Hale

# KOLEKOLE PASS IMPROVEMENTS

- Working with Navy, Army, City and County and other community members to make repairs to Kolekole Pass for use as a two-way emergency route.
- Work to open for emergency access by end of year includes paving, striping, signage, and slope preparation, mitigation, and rockfall protection. Est. Cost \$10 M.
- Total Scope: Pavement resurfacing, striping, slope stabilization, rockfall mitigation, and bridge improvements. Total Est. Cost: \$150 M



### FARRINGTON HIGHWAY WIDENING – HELELUA TO MOHIHI

- Extension of 5<sup>th</sup> lane to Mohihi Street
- Extension of shared use path on the Makai side
- Upgrade Mauka sidewalk
- RTA: December 2025
- Est. Cost: \$45 M

# FUTURE BRIDGE WORK

#### **Ulehawa Stream Bridge Replacement**

- Survey work begins July 29
- RTA: late 2025
- Est. Cost \$22 M

### Mā'ili'ili Stream Bridge rehabilitation

- Scope: Performing spall repairs of bridge deck, girders and wingwalls
- Projected Start: Spring 2027
- Est. Cost \$12 M


#### **Kaupuni Stream Bridge rehabilitation**

- Scope: Repair spalls and delaminations in concrete pier caps, abutments, bridge deck and railings
- Projected Start: Summer 2027
- Est. Cost \$14 M



# O'AHU SHARED USE PATH

- Joint plan to provide multimodal connection between Nānākuli and Mānoa
- Total cost estimate \$60 M (\$21 Mto build out parts of the path in **bold**)
